Policy and Application Instructions

- Must be a member of the Conradina Chapter Florida Native Plant Society (FNPS)
 - New memberships will be accepted with scholarship applications.
- Must be a Brevard County resident.
- Submittal of a recommendation letter and a 250-word or less essay describing:
 - Why do you want to participate in the FMNP.
 - Your expectations of the FMNP
 - How you would use the knowledge gained to benefit the Conradina Chapter of the FNPS.

- Applicants must agree to fulfill one of the following commitments within 6 months of completion of the FMNP module:
 - Choose and guide a FNPS field trip.
 - Present their FMNP project at a general Conradina FNPS meeting.
 - Submit 3 short articles for the Conradina Chapter newsletter.
- This scholarship covers the tuition of one module/course of the Florida Master Naturalist Program (FMNP). Maximum scholarship award is \$350 for the year 2026. Payment for the module/course will be made directly to FMNP upon registration.
